
I take this opportunity to extend my gratitude to the alumnae for being with us always. I remain ever obliged for their unconditional love for our children.





Flight Of An Eagle




Through the clouds and highest mountain peaks Straight into the deepest jungle and scary waters Having the strength to fly awn and awn
